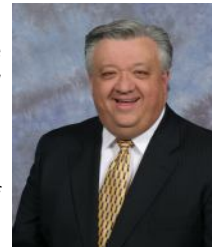
Cliff Donoho

Cliff is pastor of Rejoice FWB church in Antioch, TN and founder of Church Growth Seminars.



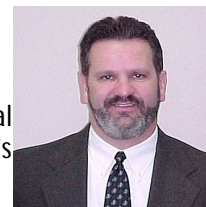
Tim York
